The keys to a high-stakes presentation Building relationships from the outset

- Set the direction of the response in the light of the specifications
- Identify the actors, the targeted messages and the relevant illustrations
- Identify the messages and form to be conveyed visually
- Use briefing sheets
- Allocate and coordinate the various tasks

Engaging the audience

- Develop a clear, concise story that gets straight to the point
- Define a dynamic plan to capture the audience's attention
- Position yourself assertively: voice, posture, gestures, visual relationship
- Apply self-management techniques
- Create a dynamic by linking and relaying information between speakers

Practising for the big speech

- Managing exchanges and interactivity with the audience
- Responding to difficult questions and bouncing back
- Practising: dress rehearsal

Quilotoa learning method:

Based on theatrical techniques, active and practical, it aims to give each participant the autonomy that is essential for lasting progress. Theoretical points of reference, passed on interactively, complement the practical exercises to help participants grasp the material.

Assessment:
